Director's Notes

When one has found an old piece of furniture, say a wardrobe or such, set aside all by its lonesome in a back room, curiosity piques. This seems odd...Why is it here, unused? What is that mysterious lettering entwined through the doors and side panels? But if that person is a child, playing hide and seek, such a wardrobe provides simply the perfect hiding place~ as long as one does not shut the door entirely. For everyone knows "it is very silly to shut oneself into a wardrobe." And so WWII refugee Lucy Pevensie, age 8, journeys into the wondrous Land of Narnia. A land void of humans but filled with talking animals, fauns, dryads and naiads, and Aslan, the absent but Regent Lion, Son of the Emperor Across the Sea.

Imprisoned in perpetual Ice and Snow, with no hope of holidays or spring thaw, the animals of Narnia carry on their days in dread of the reigning White Witch. Her joy in turning dissidents to stone has created efficacious submission throughout the land. Secretly, the true Narnians long for the Prophecy of Old to come true. "When Adam's flesh and Adam's bone sits at Cair Paravel in throne, The evil time will be over and done." A deep magic can hold a land in chains, but "deeper magic still" dethrones even the most effectual tyrant when the appointed time and figures intertwine.

Since its first publication in 1950, 120 million copies of the "Chronicles of Narnia" have been printed. I was happily surprised to note that the choice of Narnia as our spring show has brought more excitement to the studio than any other show previously done. Whether folks were currently reading the Chronicles out loud as a family, or had done so already, or had fond memories of a parent reading to them as a child, there has been a common joy in being able to celebrate such a beloved novel on stage. Immediate questions of "who would play the children, Tumnus, and Aslan?" and "how are you going to do the Stone Table?" only confirmed a vested interest.

As you know, we love throwing ourselves into stage productions- the more details the better the fun- and yet there has been a sense of solemnity about producing Narnia. There is something that resonates with the story of children playing a critical role in such a mammoth task as overthrowing a dictator, and of a hero willing to pay the ultimate price for his people. In Narnia, the battles the children and Aslan face are real and scary and dire. They require courage and grit, faith and, in Aslan's case, real sacrifice. CS Lewis' "Narnia" embodies real life, real pain, and the courage to confront the challenges we sludge through in our lives.

AND SO...as we read the novel, we too identify, we empathize with struggles and we yearn for faith in the future... Luckily, childhood can possess an eternal flame of hope. Most children do possess a trust that truth will overcome lies, that freedom can turn statues back to life, that in the end, everything will work out and the good guys will win. I don't know where you are in your life, but I do know we all need hope in our hearts, and at some points of our lives we find we need it most of all. If you are there now, this show is for you, if you have been there, may your heart resonate with its resolve, and if you are headed there may this give you future peace under pressure. Martina C.
